Re: **Notification of Asbestos Inspection and Management Plan Availability**

To: Whom It May Concern:

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires that all schools conduct detailed inspections to identify all asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) that may be present in the school environment. AHERA requires the inspection results and the associated Management Plan be submitted to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ). A copy of the Management Plan must be available and maintained at the administrative office for review by the public.

South Fork Elementary maintains a proactive asbestos awareness program. The architect responsible for the construction of the school has provided a letter stating that to the best of his knowledge, no asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) was used at this school. A copy of the letter is in the Management Plan and available for review.
